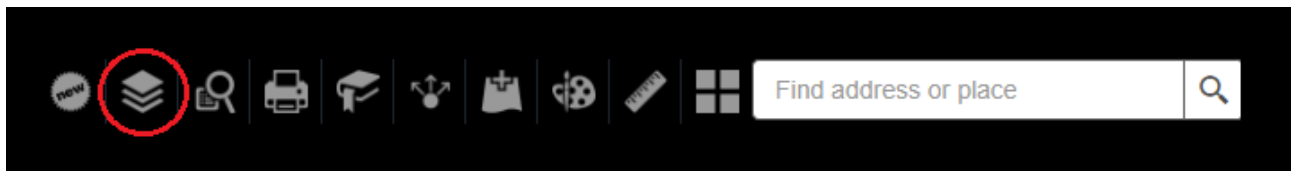

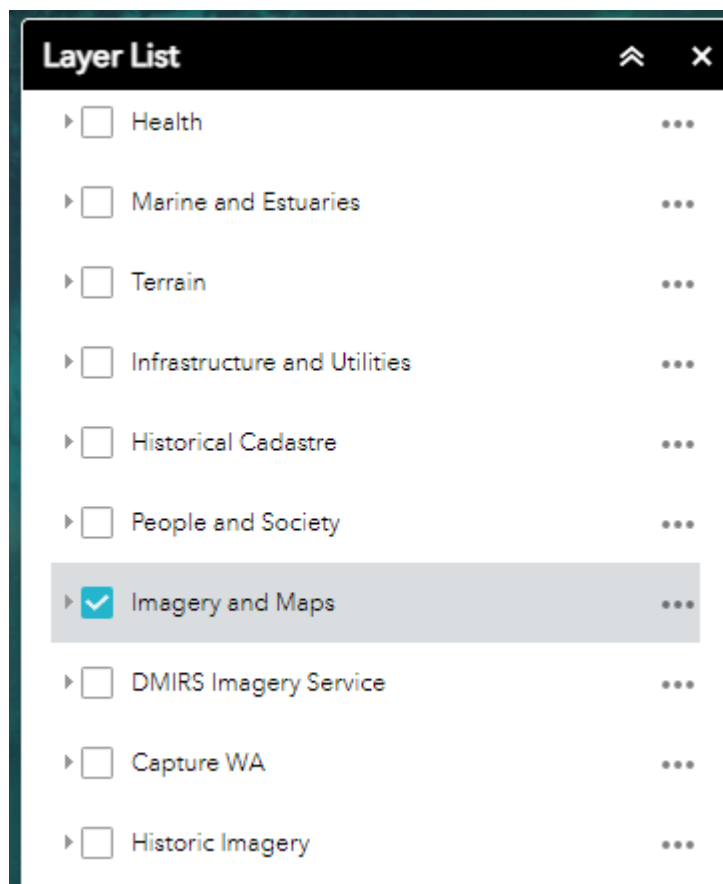
# How to identify the capture extents of available Landgate LiDAR data over Western Australia

The current LiDAR extents are easily accessed using Landgate's public map viewer called [Locate](#). Just follow the steps below.

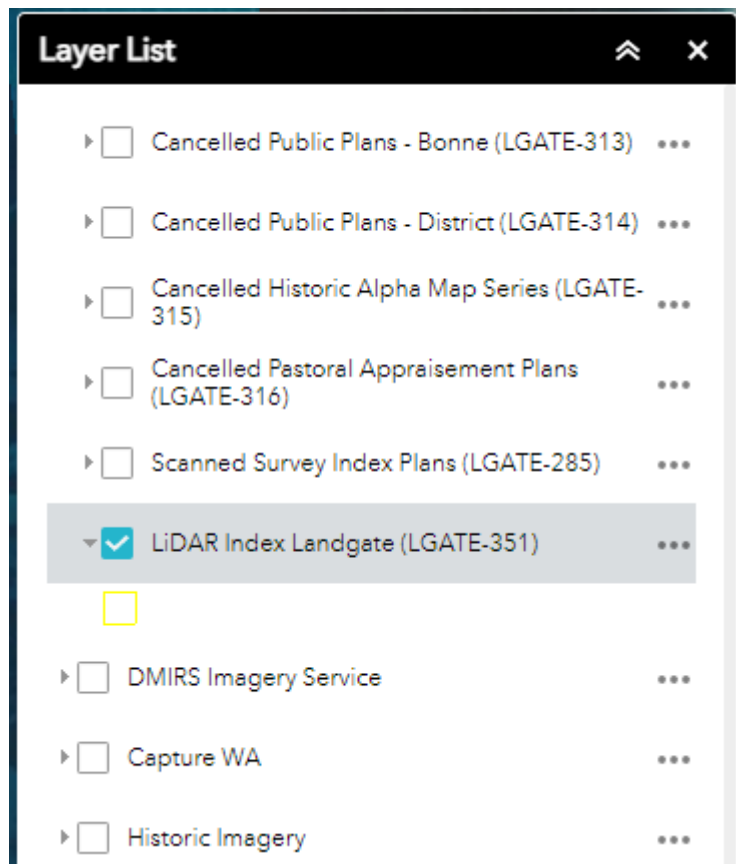
- Open [Locate](#). There will be some layers already turned on 'by default' - including aerial imagery.
- Use your mouse to zoom in and out and scroll around.
- To view the LiDAR extents, click on the Layer List icon located in the icon banner across the top of the screen (below)



- Scroll down the list and turn on Imagery and Maps



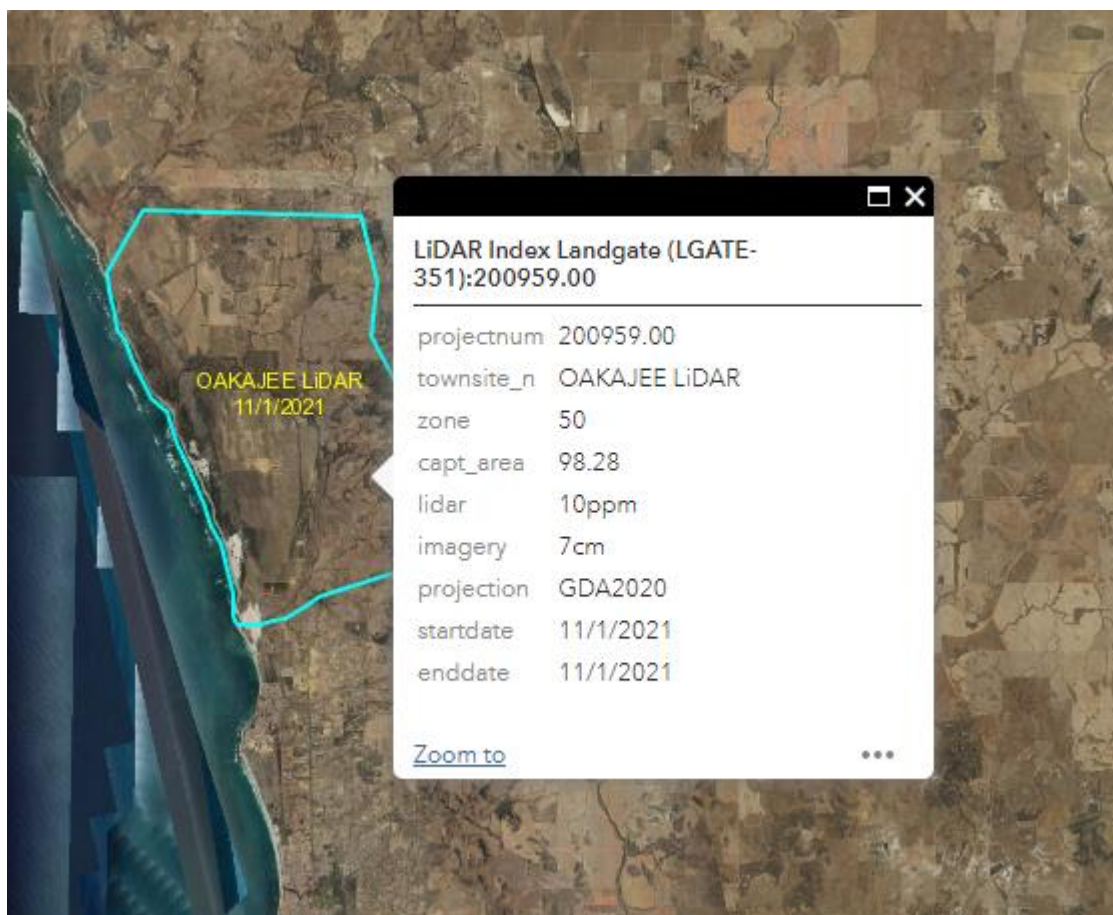
- Scroll further and turn on LiDAR Index Landgate (LGATE-351)



- Ensuring the Locate aerial mosaic is turned on (located at the base of the list). Zoom out to best observe the extent of LiDAR captures over WA.



- Clicking on the representation of the individual project extents (the yellow polygons) will provide summary metadata.
