New Digital Data Requirements: Strata Reform & GDA 2020

Strata Reform:

The *Strata Titles Amendment Act 2018* and associated Strata Titles (General) Regulations 2019 commence on 1 May 2020. To facilitate new data requirements, Landgate has updated Cadastral Survey Data (CSD) specifications for lodgement with plans.

Key changes to existing requirements are:

- New strata easements
- CSD requirements for built strata plans
- CSV requirements for built strata plans

See Annexure A for more detailed description of changes.

These new specifications apply to all plans (Strata/Survey-Strata Plans and Deposited Plans) lodged on or after **1 May 2020**.

GDA 2020:

Landgate has also updated the relevant CSD requirements for GDA 2020. Please note that the GDA 2020 requirements will not take effect until mid-2020 and an additional Notice to Surveyors will be published.

Annexure A

Description of changes to APX-05 Digital Electronic Records for Plans – Format Specification

Section 1

Added: Landgate does not require interests that are coincident with a created lot (whole of lot) to be included in the CSD file. Interests coincident with a lot severance (discontiguous part lot) are required.

Section 2.1

Added GDA2020 Attribute '0' text amendment. Landgate will append (Datum=GDA94) or (Datum=GDA2020) on lodgement of CSD files through NLR Plan Surveyor Portal.

Section 2.5

Clarification of 'tmzone' and 'projnme' values required to lodge CSD files.

Section 2.7

Added line accuracy requirements to 'distacc'.
Clarified line derivation values and their uses. Interest lines within a measured polygon are also measured.

Section 2.9

Added angle accuracy requirements to 'angacc'.
Clarified angle derivation values and their uses. Interest angles within a measured polygon are also measured.

Section 2.15.4

Clarification of expected Polygon labelling.

Section 2.15.4.1

Added *Strata Titles Amendment Act 2018* Land Usage codes.
